

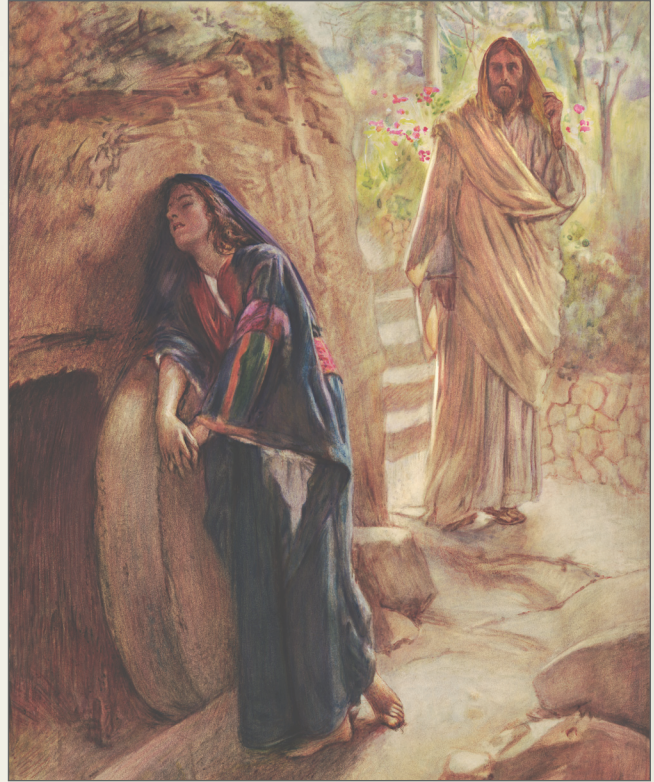


HE'S ALIVE!
