Jesus' side was pierced with a soldier's spear.

10. John 19:30

Jesus finished His work, gave up His Spirit, and died.

9. John 19:23-24

Jesus was crucified and His clothes were divided among the soldiers.

8. John 19:16

Jesus was handed over by Pilate to be crucified.

7. John 19:6

Jesus heard the Jews shouting "Crucify Him!"

3. John 18:19-23

Jesus was struck in the face by an official.

4. John 18:37

Jesus made the Good Confession.

5. John 19:1

Jesus was whipped and scourged at Pilate's instructions.

6. John 19:1-2

Jesus was mocked and beaten by the soldiers.



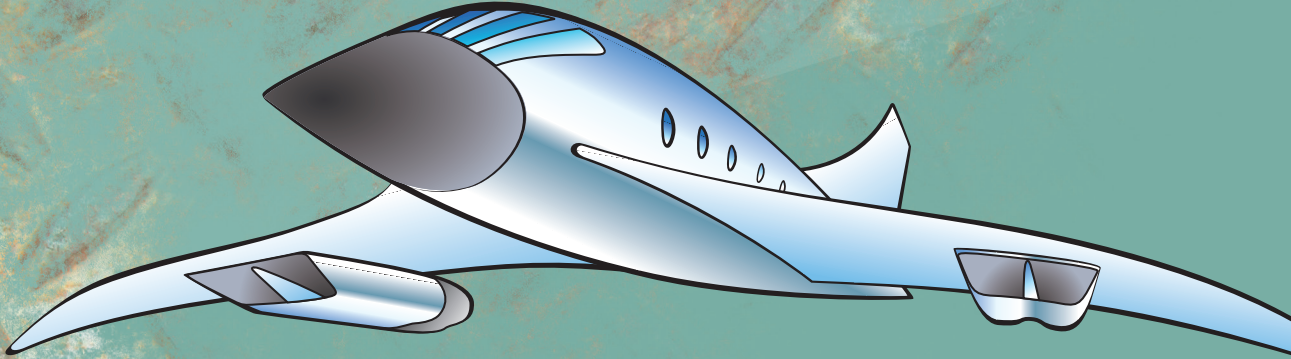
>> Which person in John 18:21 do you most identify with? Why?
